





1. Track your money

To get started, you may like to set up an automatic transfer from your regular account so that a certain amount is transferred to a high interest savings account, an investment or your super each time you receive your pay.

3. Make your super work harder for you

In addition to growing your nest egg, there are a couple of other advantages of making voluntary contributions to your super or your spouse's super. If you meet the ATO's eligibility criteria, you may benefit in the following ways:

- Receive a government co-contribution of up to \$500 to your super if you are a low or middle income earner, who has made an after-tax contribution.

- Save on taxes if you make post-tax contributions to your spouse's super.

4. Manage your debt

If you have debt with interest that isn't tax deductible, consider reducing those with the highest interest rates first. Check with your lender to ascertain if there are any early repayment penalties.

Other ways that may help manage your debt include making repayments more frequently or consolidating your loans.






CARDINAL NEWMAN Faith Resources was founded in 1974 by Father James Tierney who was alarmed that catechesis was almost non-existent since Vatican II.







21st Century Learning

An integrated design solution



MORE THAN just funky furniture, a contemporary learning space relies on many design techniques to create an integrated design solution.

Re-purposing of learning spaces at St Kieran's Catholic Primary School Manly Vale is a recent case study. It is important to note that regardless of how hard the design team works, nothing is achieved unless the teaching staff embrace and drive change; that's exactly what happened here.

The Library at St Kieran's presented an opportunity for a large column free space to be re-purposed to open learning space. This was a significant step towards student-centred learning in order for task-based spaces to occur. Despite some natural apprehension, teaching staff assured everyone that the new

learning environment was based on empirical study and would provide the students with real opportunities to develop their 'soft skills'. These include an ability to collaborate in small and large groups therefore developing communication skills beyond those developed in a standard classroom.

The room was divided into separate task-based zones to provide a wide range of activities and supported using technology. Students who are kinetic learners (i.e. struggle to sit still), can use stand up tables to carry out their tasks or sit on lower lounges and ottomans.

To combat the feeling of complete openness, new purpose-built joinery was designed. This serves as a space divider, resources storage unit, writing

surface, pinboard space, and sliding panels provides the added advantage of lengthening the sightlines in the room.

Walls are consistently covered in pinboard material for acoustic benefits in a space accommodating up to 85 students. This was a critical element to get right as acoustic disruption is typically where open learning environments fail.

Lighting in the room was improved through the installation of new LEDs and clear curtains were introduced to assist with separation of spaces and further acoustic treatment.

Students have embraced their new learning environment and praised the Paynter Dixon team, led by dedicated and passionate teaching staff at St Kieran's, for a great result.


