St Clare's was among the top 100 high schools, placing 74th in *The Sydney Morning Herald* rankings. We also recorded 70 Distinguished Achievers, three All Rounders and one Top Achiever. The results reflect the dedication and hard work of the cohort and staff. The growth demonstrated by these students was truly impressive. These fantastic results reflect some of the most significant growth the College has seen.

2022 HSC HIGHLIGHTS:

- **70 Distinguished Achievers** - these students achieved a result in the highest band (Band 6 or Band E4) for one or more courses, not including results for courses studied external to their school.
 - **Three All Rounders** - these students scored above 90 in at least 10 units - **Matilda Groves** (ATAR 98.35), **Isabelle Matouk** (ATAR 96.85), and **Ava Camillos** (ATAR 96.45).
 - **One Top Achiever** - **Chloe Colman** achieved a place in the top 20 in NSW in Standard English and also achieved a result in the highest band (Band 6 or Band E4).
 - **Our College Dux** - **Chloe Colman** achieved College Dux with her ATAR of 99.35, followed closely by **Lara Burns'** ATAR of 98.8.
- Our Distinguished Achievers also included three accelerated students from Years 9 and 11. **Anna Vincent Hull** (Year 9), **Lily Wendler** (Year 11) and **Jennet Riza** (Year 11) all achieved Band 6 results in Advanced Maths. *We warmly congratulate the 2022 HSC cohort!*

Using privilege for purpose

GEORGE MOURANI has been up since 5am watching the football. It's an early start, but for a man who is a Sydney Lawyer at Clayton Utz during the day, a night patrol volunteer for St Vincent de Paul's at night, and the Chair of the Football Canterbury Appeals Tribunal in-between, he seems to have boundless wells of energy.

"I am the type of person who prefers to do a single task with 100% effort, than multiple tasks at 50% effort. When I was in high school, I faced a crossroads about where I wanted to be in the next five years.

I had to decide between a professional football career or to become a lawyer - unfortunately I could not do both, at least with 100% dedication to each" he said.

In hindsight, he is happy that he chose law.

George says the practice of law is largely about building client relationships, finding solutions to complex issues, and contributing to the administration of justice.

George's desire to help others doesn't stop when he clocks off from work. Since he was 14 he has been volunteering for the St Vincent

de Paul Society, and during his university years he decided to study a single law degree, rather than a double degree, so that he could take on more extra-curricular activities.

While on night patrol with Vinnies, George serves homeless people a hot drink and snacks before sitting down with them to talk.

Most of the time just asking how their day was can make a big difference.

"I find they do not want our sympathy. They want to be seen, acknowledged, and heard.

It is disappointing that they have set low expectations from us, and it shows

we must be doing a lot more," George said.

"Night patrol is how I serve my broader community, and I urge everyone to do it at least once in their life.

Homelessness is deeper than a media or political

headline. It is a real issue in our modern society and they deserve to be treated with the same dignity as anyone else."

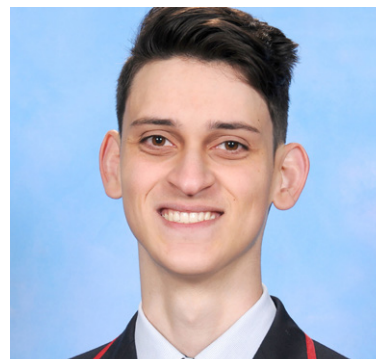
