Having ranked 93rd in the State, Marist College Eastwood celebrate their strong HSC results including 50% of ATAR students achieving a minimum of one Band 6 with 107 Band 6's achieved across 23 subjects and 56% of students achieving in the top two Bands.

# Outstanding results for Sydney Catholic Schools

St Clare's College Waverley's results were above state average in all HSC courses its students completed in 2023.

The college is among close to a quarter of Sydney Catholic schools that recorded more than 90 per cent of courses above state average, alongside Marist College Kogarah (96.9) and St John Bosco College Engadine (96.8).

#### Faith and academic excellence

Sydney Catholic Schools students took out five of the top nine places in Studies of Religion II and three of the top eight places in Studies of Religion I.

Marist Sisters' College Woolwich graduate Gabriella Michalopoulos placed first in Studies of Religion I from among 8,299 students.

Brigidine College Randwick student Yasmeeen Janschek said she was excited to have placed first in Studies of Religion II.

"It was all down to my teacher, Ms Wood," she said. "She took me through every part of the syllabus in such detail and marked my responses with very specific feedback."

Outstanding results in the 2023 HSC have strengthened Sydney Catholic Schools (SCS)' position as one of Australia's top performing school systems.

Nine of SCS' 33 secondary schools were among the 100 top-performing schools across NSW, while 18 joined the top 150, according to The Sydney Morning Herald's HSC rankings.

SCS also recorded an impressive 2,780 Distinguished Achievers and eight First in Course awards.

Executive Director of Sydney Catholic Schools, Tony Farley, said the results were a testament to the dedication and hard work of students and the expertise and support of teachers and staff.

"The Class of 2023 should be immensely proud of not only their

results, but of the way they applied themselves so diligently throughout their senior years of school," Mr Farley said.

"We hope that the determination, resilience and ability that they have shown during the HSC stays with them as they enter the next phase of their lives."

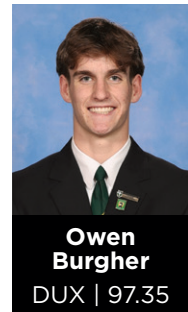

# Career preparation that goes beyond theory



PREPARING FOR a future career path is never simple – on top of the long list of study requirements are the necessary hours of professional learning, potential pro-bono work, obligatory placements and ongoing accreditation.

In the Catholic tradition the rigorous preparation for a specific mission – such as being a teacher, priest, nurse or business leader – is commonly known as formation. Formation is the exploration of the theory of a chosen vocation (what you learn at university) and the practice of it (the being and the doing).

Trish McCarthy has the crucial task of leading Australian Catholic University (ACU) education students through a rich formation experience, known as the *Signum Fidei* program, to meet the needs of employing Catholic schools.

Consisting of four modules, the program aims to equip participants with the knowledge, skills, and expertise to contribute to the mission of Church communities, specifically Catholic schools.

the Catholic Church, to help them understand the history and context of these Catholic organisations, so it’s not so confronting on the first day on the job,” Trish said.

“It’s about breaking down some of the barriers, and some of the mystery and confusion around Catholic life and practice, so they

feel comfortable working in these environments and participating in the life of the school or the hospital or the employment agency.”

ACU Bachelor of Education (Secondary)/Bachelor of Arts (Humanities) student Jaimi-Lea Andrews joined *Signum Fidei* to give her the language to support young

people in their search for meaning. The program allowed her to reflect on her own high school experiences. It was one of Jaimi-Lea’s teachers who inspired her to take her Catholic faith seriously. Although she attended Catholic schools her whole life, she wasn’t interested in the faith, and going to church on a Sunday

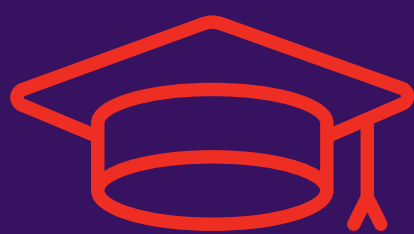

“was something other families did”.

“I got to Year 10 and I had a teacher who would actually answer my questions and said that he believed in God and went to church, and that really caught my attention,” Jaimi-Lea said.

Now a youth minister on the Central Coast and an aspiring religious education (RE) teacher, Jaimi-Lea said the *Signum Fidei* program had connected her with other aspiring RE teachers at ACU, who are also committed to their Catholic faith.
